An Act for enabling the Southwark Bridge Company to raife a further Sum of Money, and to amend the Acts for building the faid Bridge.

[23d May 1818.]

HEREAS an Act was passed in the Fifty-first Year of the Reign of His present Majesty, intituled An Act for erecting 51G.3.c.166. a Bridge over the River Thames, from or near The Three Cranes in the Parishes of Saint James, Garlick Hithe, and Saint Martin Vintry, in the City of London, to the opposite Bank of the faid River, in the Parish of Saint Saviour, in the County of Surrey, and for making proper. Streets and Avenues to communicate therewith: And whereas an Act was passed in the Fifty-third Year of the Reign of His faid Majesty, intituled An Act to amend an Act passed in the Fifty-first Year of 53G. 3. c. 87. His present Majesty, for erecting a Bridge over the River Thames, from the City of London to the opposite Bank, in the Parish of Saint Saviour, in the County of Surrey : And whereas an Act was paffed in the Fifty-fixth Year of the Reign of His faid Majesty, intituled An Act to amend Two Acts of 56G.g.c. II. His present Majesty, for erecting a Bridge over the River Thames, from the City of London to the opposite Bank, in the County of Surrey: And whereas the faid Company have proceeded in the Execution of the feveral Works authorized by the faid recited Acts, and have nearly completed the faid Bridge, and Part of the Roads therein mentioned: And whereas for the more speedy and effectual Completion of the Remainder of the faid Bridge, Roads, and Works, it will be expedient that the faid Company should be authorized to raise a further Sum of Money, and that the faid Acts should be amended : May it therefore please Your Majesty that it may be enacted; and be it enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty, [Local.] by

by and with the Advice and Confent of the Lords Spininual and Temporal, and Commons, in this prefent Parliament affembled, and by the Authority of the fame, That it shall and may be lawful for the faid Company of Proprietors, and they are hereby authorized and empowered to raile a further Sum of Money not exceeding One hundred thousand Pounds over and above the Sums authorized to be raifed by the faid Acts, in Manner hereinafter menfioned; and by all, or any, or either of the Ways or Means by which the fait Company are authorized to raile any Money by virtue of the faid recited Acts, or either of them.

Company may grant Bonds to their Clerk or Treasurer.

II. And be it further enacted, That it shall and may be lawful to and for the faid Company of Proprietors, and they are hereby authorized and empowered, from Time to Time, to grant any Bond or Bonds, under the Common Seal of the faid Company of Proprietors, for any Sum or Sums of Money not being lefs than the Sum of One hundred Pounds on each Bond, with Interest for the same not exceeding the Rate of Five Pounds per Centum per Annum upon the Credit of the Tolls authorized to be raifed and collected by virtue of the faid recited Acts, not exceeding in the whole the faid Sum of One hundred thousand Pounds.

III. And be it further enacted, That it shall and may be lawful to and **Power to fell** for the Committee or Court of Direction of the faid Company, from Time fuch Bonds. to Time to make Sale and dispose of all or any of the faid Bonds to be granted as aforefaid, either by Private Contract or Public Sale, to any Rerbh 3f Perfons whomloever, for the belt Prive or Prices in Money that can be realignably had or obtained for the fame, or to hypothecate, mortgage, and allign the lame as a Security for any Sum or Sums of Money lent or advanced thereon, fuch Allighments to be entered by the Clerk to the faid Company in Manner directed by the faid first recited Act, with relpect to Affignments of Mortgages or Annuities.

Holden of Bonds to ftand on equal Footing.

Company may renew Promiffory Notes isfued under former Acts.

IV. Provided always, and be it further enacted, That the Holders of fuch Bonds shall stand upon the same Footing the one with the other, in respect of their Right to the Payment of the Interest upon fuch Bonds, without any Priority among themfelves, notwithstanding the Sums of Money for which such Bonds shall have been issued may have been advanced at different Times.

V. And whereas the faid Company were authorized in and by the faid recited Acts, or some or one of them, to raise Money by Promillory Notes under the Common Seal of the faid Company, and it may be found convenient for the Purpoles of the faid Company that fuch Notes hould be renewed from Time to Time; be it therefore further enacted, That it shall be lawful for the faid Company, from Time to Time as Occation thall require, to renew any Promissory Notes already isfued, or which shall or may be thereafter issued by the faid Company, by issuing other Promissory Note or Notes under the Common Seal of the faid Company in lieu thereof, as to the faid Company or their Committee or Court of Direction shall seem meet and convenient.

General Power to raife Money

المركبة المركبة المركبة المتحالة المحالية VI. And be it further enacted, That it shall and may be lawful to and for the faid Company to raile all or any Part of the Monies authorized to be railed by the faid recited Acts, or either of them, and which now remains 10

remains to be raifed by all or any of the Ways by which the faid Com- remaining to pany are authorized to raife any Money by the faid recited Acts, or either be raifed under former of them, or by this Act, and allo to dispose of any of the Shares autho- Acts. rized to be created in and by the faid recited Acts, as now remain unfold or unappropriated; and alfo the Shares authorized to be created by this Act, or such Part or Parts thereof as they may deem expedient, at and for fuch Price and Prices per Share, and to fuch Perfon or Perfons as the faid Committee shall from Time to Time think proper.

VII. And be it further enacted, That no Toll shall be demanded or Exempting taken for any Horfes or Carriages belonging to their Majesties or any of Royal Fathe Royal Family, or any of the Horfes of His Majesty's Guards, or any mily. Horfes or Carriages conveying Perfons regularly attending their Majefties or any of the Royal Family.

VIII. And be it further enacted, That the faid recited Acts of the Fifty- Extending first, Fifty-third, and Fifty-fixth Years of the Reign of His present the Provi-Majesty, and all and every the Powers, Authorities, Provisions, Regula-mer Acts to tions, Privileges, Penalties, Forfeitures, Matters, and Things whatfoever this Act. therein contained, fo far as the fame are not hereby altered or repealed, shall extend, and be deemed and conftrued to extend, to operate and be in full Force and Effect with respect to all Matters and Things to be done, or which shall arise in the Execution of this Act, as fully and effectually to all Intents and Purposes as if the fame, and every of them, and every Part thereof, were repeated and re-enacted in this Act, and made Part thereof.

IX. And whereas the faid Company have made and conftructed certain Company Parts of the Roads at each End of the Bridge upon Arches, be it further may leafe enacted, That the faid Company shall have full Power and Authority to Vaults under the Roads. grant a Leafe or Leafes of the faid Arches, or any of them, to any Perfon or Perfons whomfoever, for fuch Term or Terms of Years, and for fuch Confiderations, or Rents, or other Compensations, as to the faid Company shall feem meet; and the Amount of fuch Confiderations, Rents, or Compenfations shall be paid, applied, and disposed of as the Tolls received upon the faid Bridge are by the faid recited Acts directed to be applied and difpofed of.

X. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall be deemed and taken Public Act. to be a Public Act, and shall be judicially taken Notice of as such by all Judges, Justices, and others, without being specially pleaded.
